On a request, Annette Barbetti will ask the invited speaker at the next meeting of the ACT Branch to supply a summary of his topic and slides to be uploaded to SCOA's website.

Prior to the vote to adopt the new set of Rules, Annette Barbetti briefly outlined the main amendments including removing all references to Federal Council and renaming the former Branches "local committees". Annette Barbetti said that the delegation of all local committees is expected to be complete by the end of April 2017. There were no questions from the attendees.
